Automated Service Announcement

Allied Waste is continuously looking for ways to improve our service delivery to all of our valued customers. In an effort to increase our safety focus within the community and continue to provide you with the highest level of quality service we will begin the automated garbage program for your community. Allied Waste will provide curbside collection with a 95 gallon cart, **CART CONTENTS ONLY**, for each residential unit once a week beginning **SEPTEMBER 15, 2012**. You can request an additional cart to receive additional service should you need more service.

Why Automate your Service?

- Enhance the appearance of your community by having uniform carts
- The lids are fixed to the carts
 - Reduces the amount of litter from being blown away, therefore helping to enhance the beauty of the community.
 - Odor is contained
 - Scavengers have to find another source for food
- The carts are durable and are easily moved to and from the street

Benefits of Bagging Your Trash

Allied Waste, as a partner in the community, would like to encourage every resident to bag their trash prior to placing it in the waste receptacle. This helps prevent spillage during the service of your waste. We have identified the important reasons for bagging your trash below.

- On windy days, it protects the contents of the trash container from blowing out and scattering on the ground around the community
- It helps prevent spillage during the service of your waste
- It helps prevent spillage during transportation of waste to the disposal site
- Helps keep our environment, communities and roadways litter free

Please have your Trash carts out by 7:00 a.m. to receive service.

To avoid any interruption in service please follow directions below:

- To prevent potential damage to your property, set your cart **5 feet away from all objects** such as: cars, meters, poles, trees, power lines or other obstacles. **10 feet away from mailboxes**.
- Please do not overfill carts or place items on closed lid.
- Position the cart with the handles facing towards your home and wheels placed against the curb.
- Please trim trees so there is at least 14 feet of height clearance.
- Do not place liquids, dirt, rock, construction materials, concrete or large metal parts into the garbage cart.
- **NO HOT ASHES!** Hot ashes will melt or destroy the cart.
